SHRINKING AIR



Learn firsthand that air takes up space and changes due to the temperature.

MATERIALS

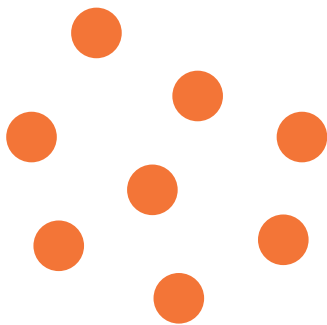
- 1 balloon
- refrigerator
- tape measure

PROCEDURE

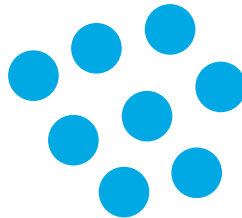
- Blow up the balloon, and tie it tightly.
- Measure the widest part of the balloon with the tape measure and record the measurement.
- Put the balloon in the freezer for one hour.
- Remove the balloon from the freezer and measure it again at the widest point. Did it change size?
- Let the balloon stay at room temperature for another hour and measure it a third time.

DID YOU KNOW

As the air in the balloon cools, the molecules in the air move closer together, causing the balloon to contract.
