		In the past 5 days**, my camper has tested positive for COVID-19.
		My camper is currently awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test taken due to possible exposure or symptoms and not from routine asymptomatic screening.
		A public health or medical professional has instructed my camper to self-monitor, isolate or quarantine because of concerns of COVID-19 infection.
		My camper has taken fever-reducing medication before coming to camp.
		My camper has travelled internationally within the last 5 full days** AND is <u>NOT</u> up-to-date* on COVID-19 vaccination.

Your camper is eligible for camp but required to mask during indoor camp activities IF:

- King County COVID-19 Community Level is “High”
- Your camper is between days 6-10 of recovery from COVID-19 and is no longer testing positive
- Your camper reports or exhibits symptoms consistent with COVID-19 during camp, while waiting in isolation to be picked up
- Your camper has been exposed to suspected or confirmed COVID-19 within the last 5 full days**, including if a household member is reporting or exhibiting symptoms

*Individuals are up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccination: (1) 2 weeks after completing the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna if no additional doses are indicated, OR (2) immediately after receiving a booster dose.

** Note that the last day of travel, the last day of potential exposure, the first day of symptoms, or the date of positive test result are *Day 0* for the purpose of counting days for quarantine or masking purposes.
