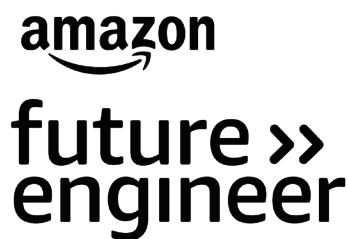

You Will Have a Guest Speaker

Your group is going to have a Digital Discovery Workshop with Pacific Science Center.

This means a guest speaker will make a video call and teach you about a science topic.



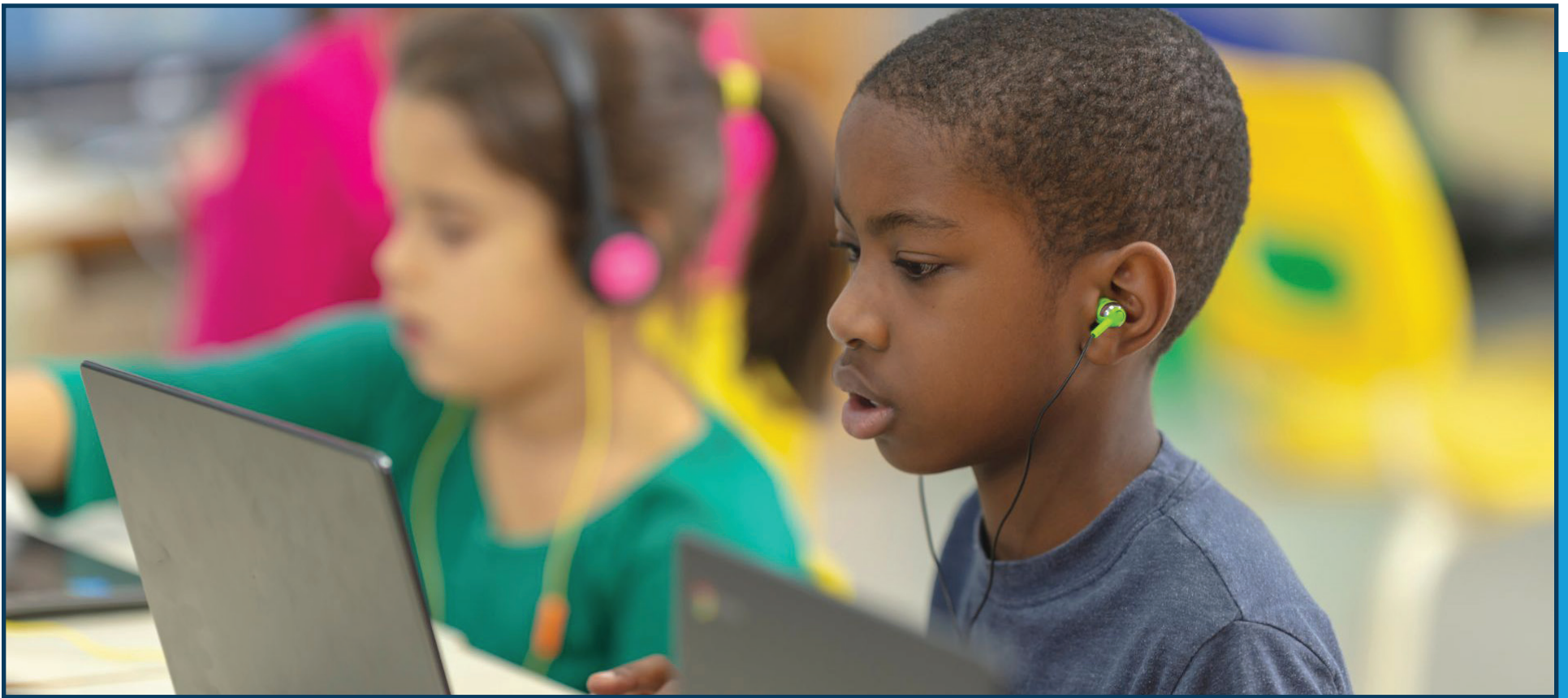
Video Call to Big Screen

At your scheduled time, the guest speaker will video call to a screen in your room.



Video Call to Your Device

At your scheduled time, the guest speaker will video call on your computer or tablet.



Setting Up

Your teacher will talk to the guest speaker to get ready for your workshop. Sometimes, there are technology problems they need to fix before the workshop starts. You can keep following instructions on what to do while you wait. This will help your teacher focus.



Time to Start!

Once everything is ready, the guest speaker will share some rules that will help make sure everyone can have fun during the workshop.

Listening to the Speaker

The guest speaker will talk to you about science. They might show you photos, videos, and experiments on the screen. You can listen quietly to learn and observe.



Your Turn to Participate

At times, the guest speaker will invite you to participate by raising hands, moving your body, or turning and talking to someone nearby.



Taking Turns to Ask Questions

You can take turns talking and listening with the other students. You can stay on topic by sharing ideas related to the science question the guest speaker asked. This will let us all have a turn to share ideas and questions.



Say Goodbye

The workshop will last about 40 minutes. At the end, it will be time to say goodbye as the guest speaker logs off the video call. Then it will be time to move onto the next activity in your day.
